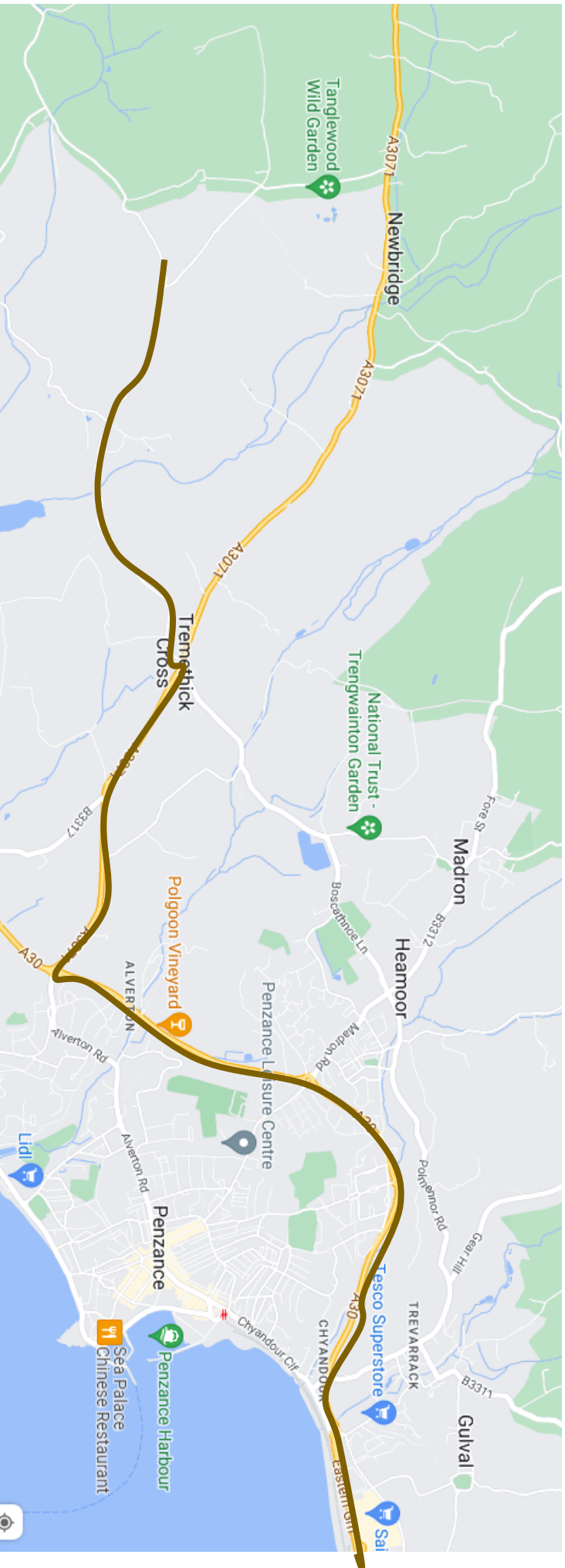

- 2.** Protests must be accompanied by a deposit of £25.00 (Twenty-five pounds) to be forfeited if the committee consider the protest to be frivolous or otherwise not reasonable.
- 3.** The Judge's decision is final. No person may address the Judge whilst adjudicating unless requested by them.
- 4.** Any questions arising about any animal exhibited shall be decided by the Hon. Veterinary Surgeon.
- 5.** No horse or pony is to be entered more than once in each class.
- 6.** The committee reserve the right to make any alterations they think fit.
- 7.** Correct British Standard headgear to be worn at all times when mounted with chinstraps fastened.
- 8.** No competitor shall show a stallion for which they are responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any competition, without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury.
- 9.** The onus is on every rider who suffers a fall, or anybody who suffers a fall or anybody who suffers an injury on the showground to report the fall / injury to the show secretary.
- 10.** If a competitor enters two classes which run at the same time in different rings, they must choose between them; classes will not be held up for a competitor.
- 11.** All ridden ponies must be 4 years old and over.
- 12.** Any foals being shown must be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the show.
- 13.** All cups are perpetual and will need to be returned at least 6 weeks before the next show. A £10 deposit will be required before any cup can leave the secretary's tent. The deposit will be returned when the cup is given back to the show committee. Any failure to return cups will be treated as theft.
